Option 1 – Velma’s Pets as Therapy

Velma’s Pets as Therapy provides a trained, accredited volunteer and pet program to visit the people in nursing homes, retirement villages, aged care or health care facilities with the prime purpose of bringing fun, joy, physical, social and mental stimulation.

Option 2 – RSPCA NSW

The RSPCA is a community based charity that works to prevent cruelty to animals by actively promoting their care and protection. They also provide shelters and veterinary hospitals.

Option 3 - Animal Welfare League NSW

The Animal Welfare League is Australia’s second largest animal welfare charity and is run to promote the welfare and protection of all animals. They also run two animal shelters, managing the surrender, care and adoption of animals. A team of inspectors is operated through the AWL who investigate allegations of cruelty and prosecute under the provisions of the Prevention to Cruelty of Animals Act.

Option 4 – Monika’s Doggie Rescue

Monika’s Doggie Rescue is a private registered charity that believes in saving and re-homing as many dogs as we can from the council pounds. Monika’s Doggie Rescue has a NO KILL policy so all dogs we get from the pound are re-housed. This policy includes accepting former DoggieRescue dogs back if their owners discard them.
