Local Dog Parks

We thought that we should let everyone know about some dog parks in the local area that are fenced or have off-leash areas. If you are taking your dog to an off-leash park, ensure that they are under voice control at all times and are social with other dogs.

- * Vale of Ah, Auld Ave, Milperra - Fenced off-leash park. This is not fenced against the Georges River so if your dog likes to go for a swim, be careful at this park.
- * Riverwood Park, Coleridge St, Riverwood - Fenced off-leash park.
- * Helena St Reserve, Helena St, Kirrawee - Fenced off-leash park, with a separated area for small and large dogs to be separate from each other.
- * Freeman Ave Reserve, Railway Pde, Canley Vale - Fenced off-leash park including toilets.
- * Cnr Kembla St & Townsville Rd, Wakeley - Fenced off-leash park including toilets.
- * Hawthorne Canal, Lilyfield & Canal Rd, Leichhardt - this is not fenced and is home to the famed Cafe Bones, the creator of the 'Pupacino'.
- * Lower Gannons Park, Forest Rd, Peakhurst - this park is not fenced.
