## Christmas Wishing Tree

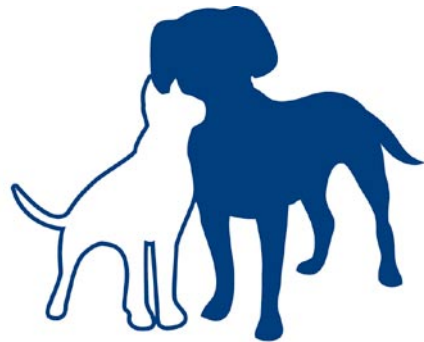
For Christmas this year, we will be supporting the Animal Welfare League in their plight to rescue and help needy animals.

## Flea Season

With flea season in full swing, now is the time to ensure that you have selected an effective flea treatment and stick to it over the coming months for the health and comfort of your beloved dog. Flea season runs from early Spring and runs until the end of Summer.

Once the warmer weather is here the fleas begin to hatch and infest our pets and living areas. Flea treatment is as simple as using flea drops or tablets such as K-9 Advantix, Exelpet, Frontline and Frontline Plus. Ask your vet for further information. Flea treatments can be purchased at any veterinary hospital or pet store and is according to your dogs weight.

A few tips to keep in mind when treating your pets for fleas:

- Treat all pets at the same time
- Treat your pet's bedding and environment
- Maintain the program all year round, particularly throughout the warmer, humid months when fleas are most active.

We are thrilled to announce that we are finalists in the Canterbury-Bankstown Express Business Achiever Awards in the categories of New Business and Specialty Store.

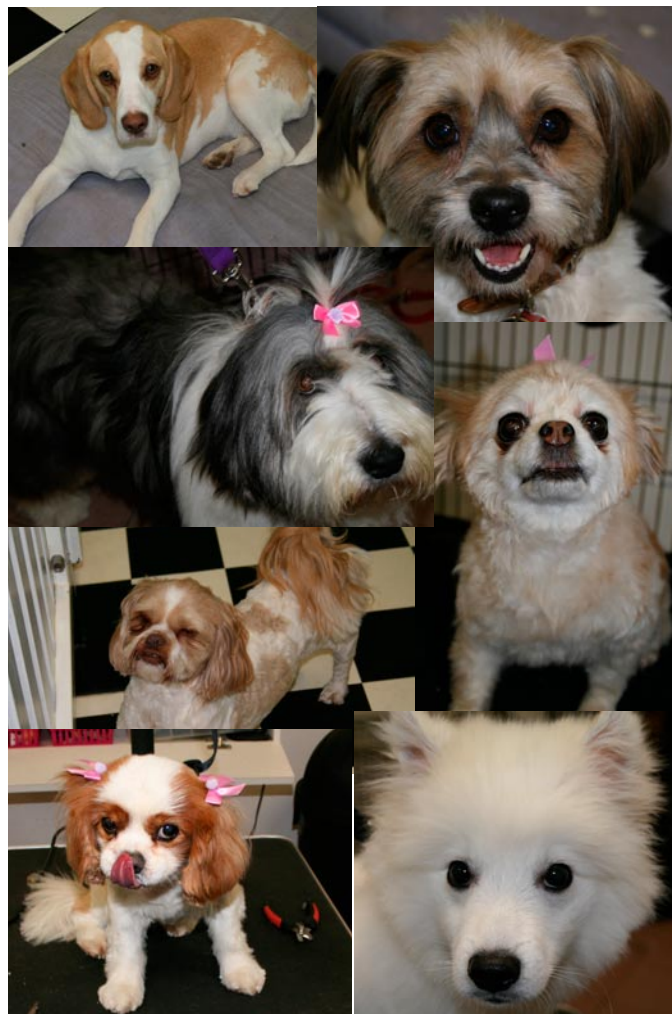
We would like to send out a big thank you to everyone who voted for us. We appreciate your ongoing support.
